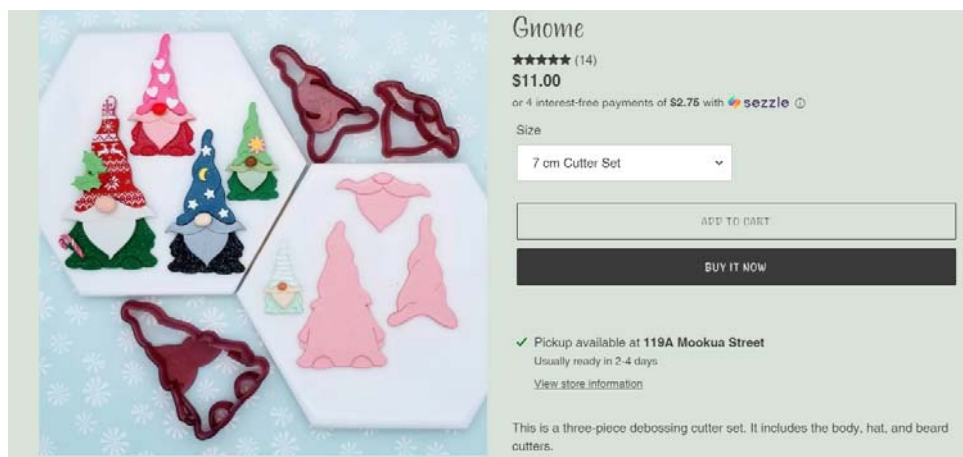

Polymer Clay Veneer Using Glue Gun Stamp and Chalks

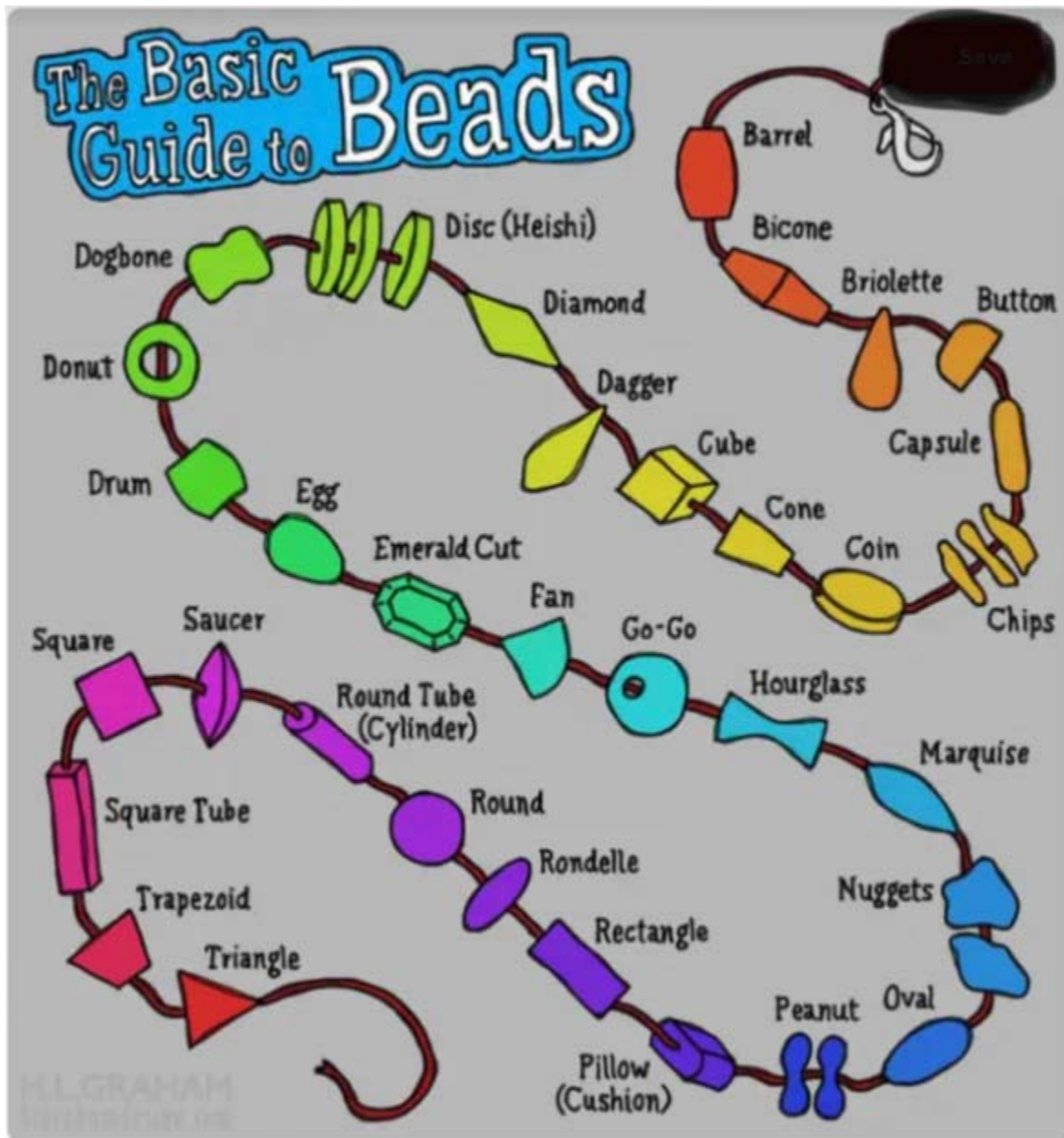
Video Tutorial
