Or just...because you feel the pull.






2023 – 100 Days Of Color Blends

Basic Blend 1 One color with white






Basic Blend 2 Two colors (NO white)






Complex Blend 1 Three colors (NO white)






Complex Blend 2 Three colors with white










2020 - 100 Days of small covered bottles




This was my first 100 day project to showcase my canework.

2020 - 100 Days of finishing things








I had so much fun that I didn't want to wait to start a new 100 day project. This project reinforced and possibly increased my dislike of working with jump rings.
